









Akwa Ibom state plans to spend **N37I.30bn** in 2017. The state government is to generate **N31bn** internally.

The sum of N169.29bn (45.6% of the projected budget) is to be spent on recurrent expenditure while N202bn(54.4% of the projected budget) is to be spent on Capital expenditure.

Akwa Ibom state government plans to source her 2017 budget deficit of **N119.54bn** from internal borrowing.

Akwa Ibom state External debt stood at \$50.56m while Internal debt stood at N155.43bn as at December 31st 2016.
