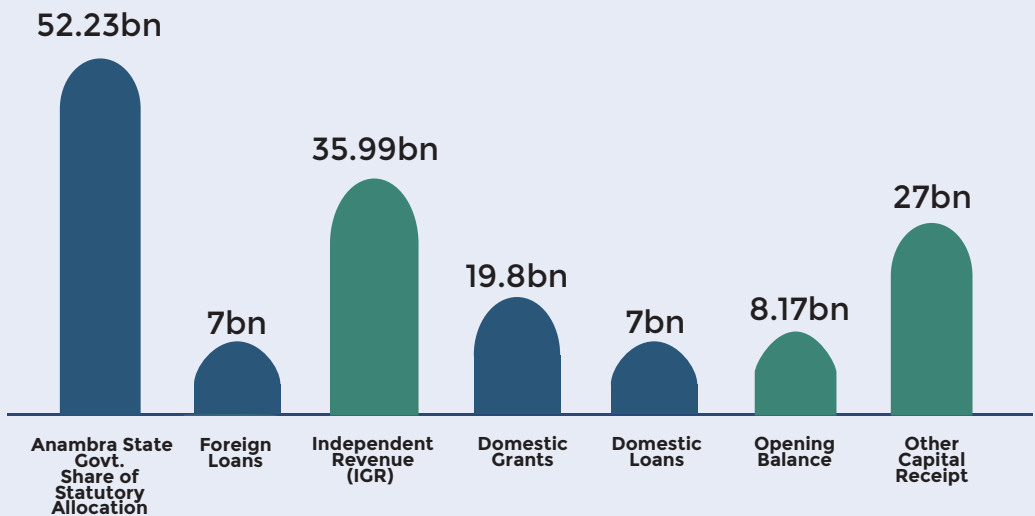

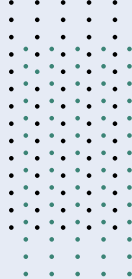
Revenue Breakdown

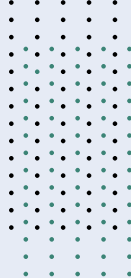

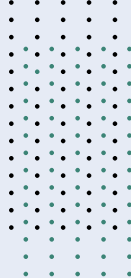

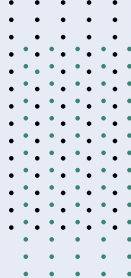

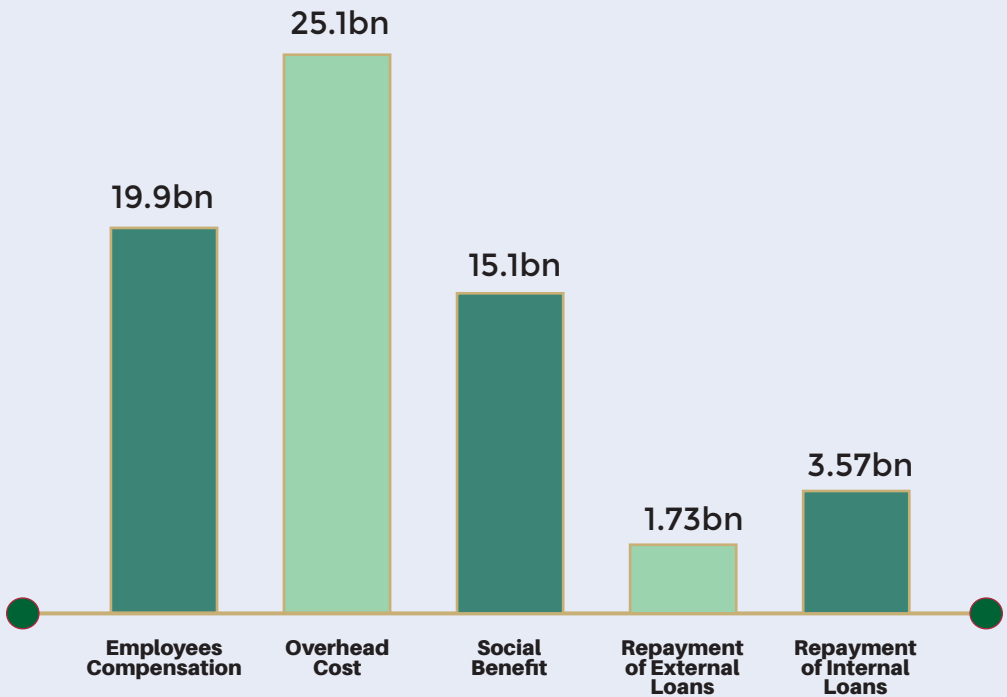
